SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. <u>58772</u> entered today, the Commission amended Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 by adding an exemption relating to commodities transported from retail stores or retail store warehouses. In accordance with that decision, the other minimum rate tariffs will be amended by separate orders to avoid duplication of tariff distribution.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5 (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 32504, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective July 31, 1959, Twenty-first Revised Page 13, which page is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

(2) That in all other respects said Decision No. 32504, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
