By Decision No. 56269, dated February 25, 1958, the Commission authorized The Western Telephone Company to issue \$2,456,000 of notes to the United States of America, acting through the Rural Electrification Administration, for the purpose of financing the cost of expanding, rehabilitating and improving its facilities and service, and of paying outstanding indebtedness.

The Commission required the company to deposit the proceeds from the issue of the notes in a special bank account.

At the outset, the Commission authorized the company to withdraw not to exceed \$906,438 of such proceeds for the purpose of paying
