ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

By Decision No. 54009, dated October 30, 1956, in this proceeding, Pacific Truck Service, Inc., a corporation, was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier for the transportation of certain specified commodities in bulk, in tank vehicles, generally between all points and places in the State of California, over specified routes.

Decision No. 54009, supra, ordered that, in providing service pursuant to the certificate therein granted, Pacific Truck Service, Inc., shall, within the period therein specified, establish the service and file and concurrently make effective tariffs satisfactory to the Commission. The required tariffs not having been filed, and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that such failure constitutes good cause for the revocation of the certificate,


IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted Pacific Truck Service, Inc., a corporation, by Decision No. 54009, dated October 30, 1956, in Application No. 35943, is hereby revoked.


The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Pacific Truck Service, Inc.


The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after service thereof upon Pacific Truck Service, Inc., unless


before such effective date it shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order denying the facts set forth herein, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.


