ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

Wayman F. Lindsay and Rodney L. Rogers, doing business as Local Freight Co., possess a highway common carrier certificate authorizing the transportation of general commodities with certain exceptions between all points and places in Los Angeles Territory as described in Appendix B to Decision No. 56714, dated May 20, 1958, in this proceeding.

The liability insurance policy of Wayman F. Lindsay and Rodney L. Rogers lapsed as of July 15, 1959. Evidence of liability protection required by General Order No. 100A not being on file, and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that such failure constitutes good cause for suspension of such certificate and of tariffs applicable to service thereunder,

IT IS ORDERED as follows:


(1) The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier granted Wayman F. Lindsay and Rodney L. Rogers by Decision No. 56714, dated May 20, 1958, in Application No. 36318, is suspended pending further order.


(2) All tariffs issued by or on behalf of Wayman F. Lindsay and Rodney L. Rogers are suspended pending further order. A copy of this order shall be filed with said tariffs in the office of the Commission.


The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Wayman F. Lindsay and Rodney L. Rogers and a copy of this order to be mailed to Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, and Western Classification Committee, Agent.


The effective date of this order shall be the fifth day after such service, unless before such effective date Wayman F. Lindsay and Rodney L. Rogers shall have filed with this Commission evidence of insurance protection as required by General Order No. 100A, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
