OPINION AND ORDER

Ray Donnell is a public utility warehouseman at Davis, Yolo County. By this application, he seeks authority to discontinue this operation.

According to the application, applicant's facilities can handle only sack storage; there is no grain in storage in applicant's warehouse at the present time; much of the acreage in the vicinity of the warehouse has been converted from grain to row crops; and there is now little or no demand for sack storage.

Upon consideration of the allegations contained in the verified application, the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity no longer require the operation of the public utility warehouse in question. Public utility storage of grain is available at other warehouses within 8 miles of Davis. The application will be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That Ray Donnell is hereby authorized to discontinue service as a public utility warehouseman at Davis, Yolo County, as proposed in the above application, subject to the following conditions:

(a) That Ray Donnell shall, within thirty days after the effective date of this order, file with the Commission his written acceptance of this order.





(b) That applicant's agent, Jack L. Dawson, shall cancel the participation of Raymond Donnell in California Warehouse Tariff Bureau Warehouse Tariff No. 24, Cal.P.U.C. No. 142, on file with the Commission. Such cancellation may be made on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.

(2) That the Power of Attorney W. E. 1 No. 2 executed by Raymond Donnell on file with this Commission in favor of Jack L. Dawson, Agent, is hereby canceled, effective upon the cancellation of the participation of Raymond Donnell from California Warehouse Tariff Bureau Warehouse Tariff No. 24.

(3) That the authority herein granted shall expire unless exercised within ninety days after the effective date of this order.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
