ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

Suburban Freight Lines, Inc., a California corporation, possesses a highway common carrier certificate authorizing the transportation of specifically named commodities between Los Angeles, on the one hand, and Pomona, Ontario, Riverside and San Bernardino on the other hand, excluding, however, the authority to render service to, from or between intermediate points.

The liability insurance policy of Suburban Freight Lines, Inc., lapsed as of July 18, 1959. Evidence of liability protection required by General Order No. 100A not being on file, and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that such failure constitutes good cause for suspension of such certificate and of tariffs applicable to service thereunder,

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

(1) The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier granted Suburban Freight Lines, Inc., by Decision No. 52771, dated March 13, 1956, in Application No. 36165, is suspended pending further order.


(2) All tariffs issued by or on behalf of Suburban Freight Lines, Inc., are suspended pending further order. A copy


of this order shall be filed with said tariffs in the office of the Commission.


The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Suburban Freight Lines, Inc., and a copy of this order to be mailed to Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent.

The effective date of this order shall be the fifth day after such service, unless before such effective date Suburban Freight Lines, Inc., shall have filed with this Commission evidence of insurance protection as required by General Order No. 100A, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
