ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

O. L. Trulove, doing business as Trulove Transfer and Storage, possesses highway common carrier certificates authorizing the transportation of freight, having prior or subsequent rail haul via The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, between that railroad's depots located in Inglewood and Los Angeles and also between the Inglewood depot and points located within a defined portion of Los Angeles County.

The liability insurance policy of 0. L. Trulove lapsed as of July 17, 1959. Evidence of liability protection required by General Order No. 100A not being on file, and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that such failure constitutes good cause for suspension of such certificates and of tariffs applicable to service thereunder,

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

(1) The certificates of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier acquired by O. L. Trulove by Decision No. 56207, dated February 4, 1958, in Application No. 39669 are suspended pending further order.

(2) All tariffs issued by or on behalf of 0. L. Trulove to the extent they cover the operations of 0. L. Trulove are suspended pending further order. A copy of this order shall be filed with said tariffs in the office of the Commission.
