## OPINION

The applicants filed this application on May 8, 1959.

They seek authority to transport bona fide pupils between their homes and institutions of learning. The area sought lies in San Mateo and Santa Clara Counties between Burlingame and Burlingame Hills on the north and Sunnyvale, Mountain View and Los Altos on the south.

The Commission advised principal carriers in the area of the application. These, The Greyhound Corporation, Western Greyhound Lines Division, and San Mateo-Burlingame Transit, have indicated that they have no objection to the granting of the application.

Applicants allege that they have received requests for this service from bona fide students desiring transportation between their homes and institutions of learning. Applicants propose to use their present equipment. other things, to file annual reports of their operations and to comply with and observe the safety rules and other regulations of the Commission's General Order No. 98. Failure to file such reports, in such form and at such time as the Commission may direct, or to comply with and observe the provisions of General Order No. 98, may result in a cancellation of the operating authority granted by this decision.

(b) Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicants shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate and concurrently make effective tariffs and timetables satisfactory to the Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
