O R D E R

In connection with the improvement of State Highway VI-Tul-4-A, near Radnor in Tulare County, the State of California, Department of Public Works is authorized to abandon and close to public use and travel the following three crossings at grade over track of the Southern Pacific Company:

- County Road 2E, Crossing No. B-278.1
- County Road 5E, Crossing No. B-275.1
- County Road 6E, Crossing No. B-274.1

Construction expense shall be apportioned by agreement between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. The County of Tulare, the applicant and the railroad are in agreement as to the necessity for the closing of these crossings.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or

safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
