SECOND INTERIM OPINION AND ORDER

This Commission having issued Decision No. 58270, dated April 14, 1959, effective May 4, 1959, prohibiting the Narbonne Ranch Water Co. No. 2 "from serving water to any new customers without securing prior approval of this Commission," and

It now having come to the attention of the Commission that several parties had obtained building permits for the construction of business and residential buildings within the service area of the Narbonne Ranch Water Co. No. 2, which permits were obtained prior to the effective date of Decision No. 58270, and

It further appearing that these parties are in need of water service and have no other source thereof, and it further appearing that the Narbonne Ranch Water Co. No. 2 can serve water to these applicants without disrupting the service to any of its existing customers,

IT IS ORDERED that the term "new customers" as used in Decision No. 58270, supra, shall be construed not to include those persons who had a bona fide issued building permit prior to May 4,

1959 for the particular building for which water service now is desired.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
