O R D E R

The City of Long Beach is authorized to construct the Ocean Boulevard Bridge at separated grades over Pacific Electric Railway Company's Seaside Park Branch in the City of Long Beach, Los Angeles County, at the location as described and in the manner as shown in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6LDA-1.81-A. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne by applicant. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

Upon completion of the structure and its being opened to use by the public, Crossing No. 6LDA-1.84, Santa Cruz Detour, approximately 130 feet southerly, shall be abandoned and closed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with.

Applicant requests waiver of the twenty-day waiting clause in order that it might proceed at the earliest possible

date. The effective date of this order shall therefore be the date hereof.
