ORDER


City of San Rafael is authorized to construct Lincoln Avenue at grade across a track of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company in San Rafael, Marin County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 5-16.9-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 44 feet and grades of approach not greater than one percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by:

1. Two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material.
2. Two 23,000 lumen mercury vapor overhead lights with one to be located on each vehicular approach side of the crossing at a distance of between 35 and 45 feet from the track centerline and at a height of about 30 feet above pavement.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time

be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. Applicant has indicated an urgent need of early handling and, therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
