ORDER

The Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Parker Street in the City of Berkeley, Alameda County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. A-8.67-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding four percent. Protection shall not be required for the reason that the tracks are located in the center of the street and such installation is not feasible. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant alleges that the industry involved contemplates immediate construction and asks that the authorization requested be made effective immediately.

Consequently, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
