ORDER MODIFYING DECISION

Ordering paragraph 4 of Decision No. 54060 requires that applicants obtain authority from this Commission prior to extending service into territory other than Tract No. 1794. The opinion states that the water supply under development at the time of the hearing was adequate only for this tract.

Applicants, through R. C. Soultz of Soultz Pump Co., by letters dated May 29 and June 26, 1959, have requested that this restriction be lifted in order that water mains may be extended into Tract No. 2243, a subdivision contiguous to Tract No. 1794. As basis for this request, applicants cite a pump test dated May 19, 1959, the results of which are attached to the letter dated May 29, 1959, from which it appears that an adequate supply of water will be available to serve the two tracts.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that Decision No. 54060 should be modified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that ordering paragraph 4 of Decision No. 54060, dated November 5, 1956, in Application No. 38053,

be and it is modified by removing the service restriction therein contained to the extent of permitting applicants to furnish water service to Tract No. 2243, Kern County.

If the authority herein granted is exercised, applicants shall file in quadruplicate with this Commission, after the effective date of this order and in conformity with General Order No. 96, revised tariff schedules acceptable to this Commission, including tariff service area map, to provide for the application of said tariff schedules to the area in which they have been authorized to furnish water service. Such revised tariff sheets shall become effective upon five days' notice to the Commission and to the public after filing as hereinabove provided.

Except as modified by this order, the service restriction contained in ordering paragraph 4 of Decision No. 54060 shall otherwise be and remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be five days after the date hereof.
