ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

Warren H. Desper, doing business as Desper Terminal & Distributing Company, possesses a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier for the transportation of crated new furniture between the Los Angeles drayage area, on the one hand, and various points and places in southern California, on the other hand.

The liability insurance policy of Warren H. Desper lapsed as of August 2, 1959.¹ In addition he has not maintained a schedule of classifications as required by Sections 486 and 493 of the Public Utilities Code.²

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier granted to Warren H. Desper by Decision No. 44825, dated September 19, 1950, in Application No. 31268, is suspended pending further order.

¹ The operative rights of Warren H. Desper were previously suspended for liability insurance lapse by Decision No. 58023, dated February 17, 1959, in this proceeding. The suspension was vacated by Decision No. 58533, dated June 2, 1959, when evidence of such insurance was filed with the Commission.

² The participation of Warren H. Desper in the Western Classification was canceled effective March 14, 1959.

(2) That all tariffs issued by or on behalf of Warren H. Desper are suspended pending further order. A copy of this order shall be filed with said tariffs in the office of the Commission.


The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Warren H. Desper and to mail a copy of this order to Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, and Western Classification Committee, Agent.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after such service, unless before such effective date Warren H. Desper shall have filed with this Commission evidence of insurance protection as required by General Order No. 100A, and has filed a freight classification as required by Sections 486 and 493 of the Public Utilities Code, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
