AK ORIGINAL Decision No. ___ 58925 BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA Application of the State of California, Department of Public Works, for an order authorizing construction of two crossings at separated grades whereby County Avenues 280 and 264 will be carried over the main line tracks of the Southern Pacific Company and the construction of a temporary Application No. 41124 detour grade crossing and the elimination of three existing grade crossings over said tracks in connection with improvement of State Route VI-Tul-4-F, in Tulare County. Said crossings at separated grades are referred to as "Tagus Overhead and "Mid-valley Overhead". ORDER State of California, Department of Public Works, is authorized to construct County Avenue 264 and County Avenue 280 at separated grades over the tracks of Southern Pacific Company, near Tagus, Tulare County, at the respective locations shown by maps (Exhibits B and C) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossings Nos. B-245.8-A and B-243.3-A, respectively. Applicant is also authorized to construct said County Avenue 280 on temporary detour alignment at grade across tracks of Southern Pacific Company at the location set forth in the application (Exhibit C) to be identified as Crossing No. B-243.31. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach shall be substantially as shown in the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75B). Upon completion of said grade crossing, Crossing No. B-243.3 (County Avenue 280) about 55 feet northerly shall be abandoned and physically closed. - 1 -

- A 41124 AK Upon completion of the two grade separation projects herein authorized, the following grade crossings shall be abandoned and physically closed: Crossing No. B-243.31, County Avenue 280 (temporary crossing) Crossing No. B-244.5, County Avenue 272 Crossing No. B-245.6, County Avenue 264 (existing alignment) (located 0.2 miles northerly of authorized Crossing No. B-245.8-A). Construction, removal and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said grade separations approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction, removal and maintenance by further order. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with.
