

County of Solano is authorized to construct County Road No. 604 at grade across tracks of Southern Pacific Company near Tolenas, Solano County, at the location described in the application as amended to be identified as Crossing No. A-50.4. Applicant and Southern Pacific Company shall bear construction expense in accordance with agreement between the parties or by further order of the Commission should the parties fail to agree. Applicant shall bear maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B), each supplemented with a reflectorized "2 TRACKS" sign. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity,

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or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
