OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, San Joaquin Compress & Warehouse Company seeks authority to make certain revisions in its rates and accessorial charges for the storage and handling of cotton at Bakersfield.

In general, it appears that the proposed tariff changes would result in reduced charges for the same service or in the establishment of new charges for services not currently offered. Applicant requests authority to make the changes effective on five days' notice for the reason that the season's operations normally begin September 1.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the proposed changes and additions are justified. The application will be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That San Joaquin Compress & Warehouse Company is hereby authorized, on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, to publish the tariff provisions as proposed in the above-entitled application.

(2) That the authority herein granted shall expire unless exercised within ninety days after the effective date of this order.

This order shall become effective September 1, 1959.
