O R D E R

The City of Los Angeles is authorized to construct Woodman Avenue at separated grades under Southern Pacific Company's Coast Route, in the City of Los Angeles, Los Angeles County, at the location described and substantially as shown on Exhibit "C" attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. E-456.0-B. Clearances shall be in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

Upon completion of Crossing No. E-456.0-B and its being opened to use by the public, Woodman Avenue Crossing No. E-456.2 shall be abandoned and closed.

Construction and maintenance costs shall be borne in accordance with the terms of an agreement to be entered into between the City of Los Angeles and Southern Pacific Company, and a copy of said executed agreement, together with plans approved by the railroad, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Within thirty days after completion of the structure pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
