SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION

By Decision No. 58267, dated April 14, 1959, in Case No. 6184, the La Mirada Water Company was directed to effect certain changes and improvements, including the following:

"Abandon the 30,000-gallon storage reservoir at Well No. 3 and abandon all booster pumps now installed at this storage facility, thereafter connect Well No. 3 direct to 924,000 gallons of new storage north of Alicante Road."

The water company now petitions to have this requirement modified inasmuch as it does not desire to abandon the 30,000-gallon storage reservoir but desires to keep it for stand-by purposes. It is the present plan to use this 30,000-gallon storage reservoir together with the booster pumps now installed as an emergency source of water which can be placed in use in the event of the failure of the natural gas engine connected to the main storage tank of the utility.

Inasmuch as this 30,000-gallon storage tank would provide an additional source of water supply, there is no reason why it

should be abandoned so long as the La Mirada Water Company operates this facility in such a manner that the water stored therein will not become stagnant and complies with all of the other requirements of Decision No. 58267, supra. Accordingly the ensuing order will modify that decision as requested.

A public hearing is not deemed necessary.

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Application as above entitled having been filed, the Commission being fully advised in the premises and hereby finding it to be not adverse to the public interest,

IT IS ORDERED that paragraph 2 of the order of Decision No. 58267, dated April 14, 1959, in Case No. 6184, be and it hereby is deleted from said order.

In all other respects Decision No. 58267 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
