ORDER

State of California, Department of Public Works, is authorized to construct State Route 75 (Benicia-Martinez Bridge) at separated grades over the main line tracks of Southern Pacific Company near Mococo, Contra Costa County, and over the spur track of Southern Pacific Company, and spur tracks of the United States of America near Benicia, Solano County, at the locations as shown by map (Exhibit B) attached to the application as amended, to be identified as Crossings Nos. A-36.4-A and A-37.0-AC, respectively. Construction shall be substantially as indicated in the application as amended. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossings approved by Southern Pacific Company and the United States Army Corps of Engineers shall be filed within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of G.O. 26-D.

within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
