By application filed July 22, 1959, Warren N. Ballinger requests authority to abandon his operation as a highway common carrier. Applicant was issued his rights by Decision No. 52654 dated February 14, 1956 in Application No. 36128. The authority was to transport general commodities with the usual exceptions between San Francisco and South San Francisco.

As justification applicant states that he wishes to dispose of his equipment and get out of the transportation business. Based upon the Commission's knowledge of transportation facilities available in this area it is found that public convenience and necessity no longer require the continuance of applicant's service. The application will therefore be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That the certificate of public convenience and necessity
acquired by Warren N. Ballinger by Decision No. 52654, dated February
14, 1956, in Application No. 36128, is revoked.

(2) That Pacific Southcoast Freight Bureau, Agent, Western Classification Committee, Agent, William M. Larimore, Agent, and Leland C. Smith, Agent, are authorized and directed to cancel, on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, the participation of Warren N. Ballinger from their tariffs on file with this Commission.

(3) That Powers of Attorney issued by Warren N. Ballinger in favor of William M. Larimore, Agent, Pacific Southcoast Freight Bureau, Agent, Western Classification Committee, Agent, and Leland E. Smith, Agent, respectively, are hereby canceled.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
