ORDER

The City of Chula Vista is authorized to construct Madrona Street at grade across San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company's Chula Vista Branch in the City of Chula Vista, San Diego County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 36B-8.6. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing and grades of approach shall be substantially as shown on the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) with reflex reflecting sheet material, located as indicated in the application.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied

with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
