ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

John N. Rocha, an individual, possesses a highway common carrier certificate authorizing the transportation of livestock between virtually all points and places within the State of California over and along twenty-six specified routes with the right to serve off-route points within fifty miles of said routes.

The liability insurance policy of John N. Rocha lapsed as of September 1, 1959. Evidence of liability protection required by General Order No. 100A not being on file, and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that such failure constitutes good cause for suspension of such certificate and of tariffs applicable to service thereunder,

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

(1) The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier granted to John N. Rocha by Decision No. 52785, dated March 13, 1956, in Application No. 36057, is suspended pending further order.

(2) All tariffs issued by or on behalf of John N. Rocha are suspended pending further Order. A copy of this order shall be filed with said tariffs in the office of the Commission.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon John N. Rocha and to mail a copy of this order to Richard A. Bennett, Agent.
