ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHTS G & G Trucking Company, a corporation, possesses a highway common carrier certificate authorizing the transportation of specifically named commodities between the Los Angeles Drayage Area, on the one hand, and Oakland and San Francisco, on the other hand. The liability insurance policy of G & G Trucking Company lapsed as of September 5, 1959. Evidence of liability protection required by General Order No. 100A not being on file, and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that such failure constitutes good cause for suspension of such certificate and of tariffs applicable to service thereunder, IT IS ORDERED as follows: (1) The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier acquired by G & G Trucking Company by Decision No. 55529, dated September 10, 1957, in Application No. 39345, is suspended pending further order. (2) All tariffs issued by or on behalf of G & G Trucking Company are suspended pending further order. A copy of this order shall be filed with said tariffs in the office of the Commission. -1A.39345-CP

The Sccretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon G & G Trucking Company and to mail a copy of this order to Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, and Western Classification Committee, Agent.

The effective date of this order shall be the fifth day after such service unless, before such effective date, G & G Trucking Company shall have filed with this Commission evidence of insurance protection as required by General Order No. 100A, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
