ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

Suburban Fuel Co., a California corporation, doing business as Statewide Tank Lines, possesses a petroleum irregular route carrier certificate authorizing the transportation of petroleum and petroleum products, in bulk, in tank trucks and tank trailers, between all points and places in the State of California.

The liability insurance policy of Suburban Fuel Co. lapsed as of September 5, 1959. Evidence of liability protection required by General Order No. 100A not being on file, and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that such failure constitutes good cause for suspension of such certificate and of tariffs applicable to service thereunder,

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

(1) The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a petroleum irregular route carrier acquired by Suburban Fuel Co. by Decision No. 56068, dated January 14, 1958, in Application No. 39597, is suspended pending further order.

(2) All tariffs issued by or on behalf of Suburban Fuel Co. are suspended pending further order. A copy of this order shall be filed with said tariffs in the office of the Commission.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Suburban Fuel Co. and to mail a copy of this order to Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent.

The effective date of this order shall be the fifth day after such service unless, before such effective date, Suburban Fuel Co. shall have filed with this Commission evidence of insurance protection as required by General Order No. 100A, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
