O R D E R

The City of Long Beach is authorized to construct four crossings at grade across city-owned trackage used by Pacific Electric Railway Company and construct a track under the existing Ocean Boulevard Bridge structure, in the City of Long Beach, Los Angeles County, at the locations as described and substantially in the manner as shown in the application. Crossings shall be identified as follows:

First Street	6LDA-1.86-C
Ocean Boulevard	6LDA-1.91-CA
Seaside Boulevard	6LDA-2.03-C

All clearances shall be in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

The foregoing authority is subject to the installation of protection as described in the appendix attached to this order.

All grade crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72 and of widths as shown in the appendix hereto, with grades of approach substantially as shown on Exhibit "A" attached to the application.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant states that industries to be served require immediate service and requests waiver of the 20-day waiting clause. The effective date of this order will therefore be the date hereof.

Crossing signs and human flagman shall be removed when flashing light signals are cut into service.
