O R D E R

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct an additional side track at grade across Boron Avenue, in the community of Boron, Kern County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 2-783.9. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72 and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) supplemented with automatic crossing gates.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one

year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
