In the Matter of the Application of INGLEWOOD CITY LINES, a corporation, for an order granting permission to increase its local basic passenger rate and fare structure for the transportation of persons.

O P I N I O N

Inglewood City Lines operates as a passenger stage corporation between points within the City of Inglewood and adjacent areas. By this application it seeks to increase fares.

The present fare structure consists of a single-zone system. The adult cash fare is 14 cents or three tokens for 40 cents. The children's fare is 10 cents cash. School tokens are available at the rate of 10 for \$1.00, or 10 cents per ride. Transfers between the various lines of the company are free.

It is herein proposed to increase the adult cash fare to 17 cents and the token fare to 6 for \$1.00. No change is contemplated in the school and children's fares.

A public hearing was held before Examiner Grant E. Syphers on August 19, 1959, at which time evidence was adduced and the matter submitted.

The applicant submitted estimated results of operations under present and proposed fares in exhibits attached to the application. At the hearing, a report prepared by the staff was offered in evidence which set forth similar data but showing a more favorable earning position than that shown by applicant.

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Applicant entered into a stipulation whereby the study made by staff engineers could be accepted into evidence without objection. This study discloses the following results of operations under present and proposed fares for the year ending August 31, 1960:


Based upon the record we find that the request of Inglewood City Lines for an increase in its fares is justified. This request will be granted.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Inglewood City Lines be, and it hereby is, authorized to increase its adult cash fare from 14 cents to 17 cents and the adult token fare from 3 for 40 cents to 6 for \$1.00, on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

2. That the authority herein granted shall expire unless exercised within sixty days after the effective date of this order.

The effective date of this order shall be ten days after the date hereof.
