O P I N I O N

A. T. L., Inc., requests authority to sell and transfer, and Pixley Transportation requests authority to purchase and acquire, certain operative rights and equipment.

The operative rights to be transferred authorize the transportation of property as an Express Corporation and as a Highway Common Carrier between various points within the state.

According to a copy of the sales agreement attached to the application, the rights and two pieces of equipment will be transferred for a cash consideration of \$2,400. A value of \$100 is placed upon the operative authority.

It is alleged that all of the issued and outstanding capital stock of both of the applicants herein is owned by a single individual; that the proposed transfer would result in corporate simplification, centralization of general and administrative activities, and the elimination of duplicate accounting and clerical practices.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion that the proposed transfer would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That on or before January 15, 1960, A. T. L., Inc., may sell and transfer, and Pixley Transportation may purchase and acquire, the operative rights acquired in Decision No. 47955, as well as the property described in Appendix A attached to the application.

(2) That, within thirty days after the consummation of the transfer herein authorized, the purchaser shall notify the Commission, in writing, of the fact and within said period shall file with the Commission a true copy of any bill of sale or other instrument of transfer which may be executed to effect said transfer.

(3) That on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, effective concurrently with the consummation of such transfer, applicants shall amend or reissue the tariffs on file with the Commission, naming rates, rules and regulations governing the common carrier operations here involved, to show that A. T. L., Inc., has withdrawn or canceled, and Pixley Transportation has adopted or established as its own, said rates, rules and regulations. The tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 80.
