ORDER MODIFYING DECISION

Decision No. 58056 of February 24, 1959, in this proceeding, granted applicant a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate vessels for the transportation of persons generally between San Francisco, Sausalito and Angel Island. On July 14, 1959, the Commission entered an order extending time within which applicant was required to comply with ordering paragraph (2)(b) of Decision No. 58056. On September 15, 1959, the Commission entered an additional order extending time, until October 15, 1959, within which applicant is required to comply with said ordering paragraph.

Applicant has advised the Commission that he desires to institute service in the immediate future and he has requested a modification of Decision No. 58056 to provide for a shorter period of time in which he may give notice to the public and make effective his tariffs and timetables.

The requested modification will be granted. The order will be made effective on the date hereof. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraph (2)(b) of Decision No. 58056, dated February 24, 1959, is hereby modified as follows:

"Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall

establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate, and concurrently make effective, tariffs and timetables satisfactory to the Commission."

In all other respects said Decision No. 58056 and supplementary orders in connection therewith shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
