OPINION AND ORDER


This application, filed August 31, 1959, requests a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing operations of school buses under contracts with two parochial schools and one unified school district. These contracts provide for payment from the schools upon a per bus, per day basis and no individual fares are to be accepted.


Because this application relates solely to operations which are exempt from Commission regulation by Section 226, as amended, of the Public Utilities Code, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that a certificate of public convenience and necessity is not required by applicant to institute and maintain this service. The application will therefore be dismissed. A public hearing would serve no useful purpose.

Therefore, based upon the above finding,

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 41453 is dismissed.
