IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF: (a) G & G TRUCKING COMPANY, a corporation, to purchase, and of SAM GUSINOW, an individual doing business as G & G TRUCKING CO., to sell, a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for the transportation of specific commodities between various points in California, pursuant to Sections 851-853 of the California Public Utilities Code; and (b) G & G TRUCKING COMPANY, a corporation, to issue shares of its common capital stock pursuant to Sections 816-830 of the California Public Utilities Code. } Application No. 39345

ORDER VACATING SUSPENSION OF OPERATIVE RIGHTS

Decision No. 59043, dated September 22, 1959, in this proceeding, provided for the suspension of the certificate of public convenience and necessity of G & G Trucking Company, a corporation, unless prior to the effective date of that decision applicant shall have filed evidence of adequate liability insurance, in which event the order would be stayed. Inasmuch as evidence of adequate insurance is now on file, the order of suspension in Decision No. 59043, supra, will be vacated.


G & G Trucking Company is hereby placed on notice that operations conducted without adequate evidence of insurance on file with this Commission is a violation of General Order No. 100A. The carrier is reminded that its belated filing of evidence of insurance with the Commission resulted in a lapse of its insurance coverage, contrary to the requirements of General Order No. 100A. In the event G & G Trucking Company should operate in the future without having the required evidence of liability insurance on file with the Commission, consideration will be given to possible penalty or other action.


Therefore, good cause appearing,


IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 59043, dated September 22, 1959, in Application No. 39345, is hereby vacated and set aside.


This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
