In the Matter of the Application of JOHN T. LANE for an order granting permission to charge less than the minimum rates on shipments transported for the Coca-Cola Company.


#### OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant holds radial highway common carrier, highway contract carrier and city carrier permits. Prior orders in Application No. 28709 have authorized applicant, under Section 3666 of the Public Utilities Code, to deviate from the established minimum rates for the transportation of syrup and empty containers and to transport pallets without charge for the Coca-Cola Company between specified points in northern and central California. The authority is scheduled to expire December 2, 1959.

By this application authority is sought to continue to deviate from the minimum rates for a further one-year period, but to increase the currently authorized rates as shown in Exhibit "A" attached to the application.

The application states that applicant has experienced increased costs in labor and fuel taxes. It alleges that the proposed increases in rates will offset the higher costs and that operations under the sought rates may reasonably be expected to be profitable during the ensuing year. Financial data submitted with the application indicates that a satisfactory return was received from the operation during the year ending September 30, 1959. The Transportation Division staff has reviewed the application and has recommended that it be granted.

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In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the proposed rates are reasonable. A public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That John T. Lane is hereby authorized to transport flavoring syrup and empty containers for the Coca-Cola Company between San Francisco and the points set forth in Appendix "A", attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, at rates no lower than those set forth in Appendix "A" hereof, in lieu of the minimum rates otherwise applicable to such transportation.

(2) That John T. Lane is hereby further authorized to transport pallets without charge in connection with the transportation involved in this proceeding.

(3) That the authority herein granted shall expire December 2, 1960, unless sooner canceled, changed or extended by order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective December 2, 1959.
