ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

The liability insurance policy of Utility Petroleum Co., a California corporation, lapsed as of November 5, 1959. Evidence of liability protection required by General Order No. 100A not being on file, and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that such failure constitutes good cause for suspension of certificates and of tariffs applicable to services thereunder,

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

(1) The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a petroleum irregular route carrier acquired by Utility Petroleum Co. by Decision No. 51770, dated August 2, 1955, in Application No. 37025, is hereby suspended pending further order.





(2) All tariffs issued by or on behalf of Utility Petroleum Co. are hereby suspended pending further order. A copy of this order shall be filed with said tariffs in the office of the Commission.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Utility Petroleum Co. and to

mail a copy of this order to Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc.,  
Agent.

The effective date of this order shall be the fifth day  
after such service, unless before such effective date Utility  
Petroleum Co. shall have filed with this Commission evidence of  
insurance protection as required by General Order No. 100A, in which  
event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until  
further order of the Commission.
