AMENDATORY ORDER

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Ordering paragraph 4, subparagraph A, of Decision No.
 58885, dated August 18, 1959, is amended to read as follows:

"A. Material: Eighteen gauge metal, or heavier,
 shall be used."

2. The paragraph headed "Description of Sign" in Appendix A
 to said Decision No. 58885 is amended to read as follows:

"DESCRIPTION OF SIGN

"A metal plate, 18 gauge or heavier, having a
 black field with yellow border and yellow
 letters and numerals having approximately the
 following dimensions:

Width of plate.....	9 inches
Length of plate.....	15 inches
Width of border.....	1/4 inch, set in 1/4 inch from outside of plate

"Displaying the word "EXEMPT" in addition to the
 crossing number assigned by this Commission to
 the crossing which the sign governs, with the
 letters in the word "EXEMPT" two inches in
 height and lines of five-sixteenths of an inch
 stroke, and with letters and numerals of the
 assigned crossing number one and one-half
 inches in height and lines of one-quarter inch
 stroke."

3. As herein amended, said Decision No. 58885 is continued in full force and effect.

The Secretary shall cause a copy of this decision to be mailed to all affected cities, counties, cities and counties and the appearances in Case No. 5979.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
