## OPINION AND ORDER

The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company seeks authority pursuant to Section 851 of the Public Utilities Code to sell certain private mobile radiotelephone equipment to Em. H. Mettler & Sons of Shafter, California.

Applicant states that, until February 28, 1959, it was furnishing this equipment to purchaser on a lease-maintenance basis under a contract dated August 31, 1950, as modified by agreements dated February 6, 1951, July 28, 1952 and November 18, 1954; that the book cost of the equipment is approximately \$11,950; that purchaser has agreed to pay and it has agreed to accept the sum of \$1,760 for the equipment; and that consummation of this transaction will not impair its operations or its abilities to perform its duties to the public.

For the reasons stated in Decision No. 59031, dated September 22, 1959, in Application No. 41211, the order herein will provide that applicant shall submit a cost determination showing any unrecovered costs related to this sale of private mobile communications equipment.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that the granting of the application subject to the conditions

The action taken herein shall not be construed to be a finding of the value of the property herein authorized to be sold.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
