## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 59113, dated October 6, 1959, in this proceeding, Jack A. Roesch was authorized to establish and operate a passenger stage service between specified points in San Bernardino County, on the one hand, and the Los Angeles Coliseum in Los Angeles, on the other hand. The decision authorized applicant to operate the service only when the Los Angeles Dodgers baseball team is playing in the Coliseum. The decision required that applicant shall file tariffs and timetables and concurrently establish the service by December 15, 1959.

By letter dated October 15, 1959, Jack A. Roesch advises that the service can only be established when the Dodgers commence their regular games next season. Since present indications are that the Los Angeles Dodgers 1960 season will not start until sometime in April, 1960, Decision No. 59113, supra, will be amended to provide an appropriate extension of time within which applicant may commence service and file appropriate tariffs and timetables. This order will be made effective on the date hereof. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Ordering Paragraph 2(b) of Decision No. 59113, dated October 6, 1959, in Application No. 41082, is hereby amended by substituting for the phrase "Within sixty days

after the effective date hereof" the phrase "On or before the date of the first National League scheduled league baseball game of 1960 in the Los Angeles Coliseum."

In all other respects Decision No. 59113 shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
