Whereas it has been called to the Commission's attention that Decision No. 59154, dated October 13, 1959, in the above application inadvertently included authority to serve the Naval Ammunition and Net Depot of Seal Beach, Fallbrook Annex, although by amendment the application has been altered to remove the request therefor.

Now, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Appendix A to Decision No. 53261 in Application No. 36105, dated June 19, 1956, is further amended by substituting Second Revised Page 1 for First Revised Page 1 as added by said Decision No. 59154.

Mueller Truck Co., by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in the decision noted in the margin, is authorized to transport general commodities between Los Angeles Territory on the one hand and the San Diego Territory on the other hand, (each as described in Appendix B attached hereto), including intermediate points except the Naval Ammunition and Net Depot of Seal Beach, Fallbrook Annex, along U. S. Highway 101 and 101 Alternate, U. S. Highway 395, State Highway 76, State Highway 78, unnumbered highway between Vista and Bonsall commonly known as Vista Way, and unnumbered highway between Bonsall and Fallbrook commonly known as Mission Road.

Applicant shall not transport any shipments of:

- (1) Used household goods and personal effects not packed in accordance with the crated property requirements set forth in paragraph (d) of Item No. 10-C of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-A.
- (2) Automobiles, trucks and buses, viz.: new and used, finished or unfinished passenger automobiles (including jeeps), ambulances, hearses and taxis; freight automobiles, automobile chassis, trucks, truck chassis, Truck trailers, trucks and trailers combined, buses and bus chassis.
- (3) Livestock, viz.: bucks, bulls, calves, cattle, cows, dairy cattle, ewes, goats, hogs, horses, kids, lambs, oxen, pigs, sheep, sheep camp outfits, sows, steers, stags or swine.
- (4) Commodities requiring the use of special refrigeration or temperature control in specially designed and constructed refrigerator equipment.
- (5) Liquids, compressed gases, commodities in semi-plastic form and commodities in suspension in liquids in bulk, in tank trucks, tank trailers, tank semitrailers, or a combination of such highway vehicles.
