SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER By Decision No. <u>59335</u>, entered today, the Commission made adjustments in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 9-A and Classification No. 1 and found that certain related adjustments should be made in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 3- A. That decision also found that, in order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution, Minimum Rate Tariff No. 3-A should be amended by separate order. Therefore, good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED: (1) That Minimum Rate Tariff No. 3-A (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 55587, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein to become effective January 29, 1960, Third Revised Page 5, which revised page is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof. (2) That tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the effective date hereof on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, and that such tariff publications shall be made effective not later than January 29, 1960; and that tariff publications which are authorized but not required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the tariff changes herein involved. _]...

- (3) That common carriers are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Article XII, Section 21, of the Constitution of the State of California, and Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code, to the extent necessary to establish and maintain the rates and charges authorized or directed herein.
- (4) That in all other respects said Decision No. 55587, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
