O R D E R

The City of Richmond is authorized to construct Enterprise Avenue at grade across tracks of Southern Pacific Company in the City of Richmond, Contra Costa County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. SAC-16.1. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-eight feet and grades of approach not greater than four percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Upon completion, Crossing No. SAC-17.9 about 700 feet northerly shall be abandoned and closed. Also an existing private crossing located about fifty feet southerly shall be abandoned and closed. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be

extended or if above conditions are not complied with. authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
