## BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

O P I N I O N

Northgate Transit Company, Inc., presently rendering a passenger stage service between points in San Francisco, Daly City and Colma, requests authority to amend several of its routes in addition to extending service to the newly developed St. Francis Heights subdivision area.

It is alleged that St. Francis Heights will eventually contain five thousand homes, that at present three thousand homes are completed and occupied; that applicant has received frequent requests for the proposed extension of service; that in the areas where applicant proposes to discontinue service because of lack of patronage no patron would be required to walk more than three blocks to the proposed routes.

Copies of the application were served upon the city attorneys of San Francisco and Daly City, the Board of Supervisors of San Mateo County, Peninsula Bus Lines and The Greyhound Corporation. Peninsula Bus Lines indicated by letter that it would have no protest to the application provided applicant did not

provide a competitive service along Mission Street. The authority hereinafter granted will provide for service along Junipero Serra Boulevard rather than Mission Street.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority sought. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Northgate Transit Co., Inc., authorizing the transportation of passengers between the points and over the routes as set forth in Appendix A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

(2) That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

- a. Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted. By accepting the certificate of public convenience and necessity herein granted, applicant is placed on notice that it will be required, among other things, to file annual reports of its operations and to comply with and observe the safety rules and other regulations of the Commission's General Order No. 98. Failure to file such reports, in such form and at such time as the Commission may direct, or to comply with and observe the provisions of General Order No. 98, may result in a cancellation of the operating authority granted by this decision.

- b. Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate and concurrently make effective, tariffs and time-tables satisfactory to the Commission.

(3) That concurrent with the inauguration of service heretofore authorized the operating authority granted by Decision No. 54870 is hereby revoked.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

Northgate Transit Co., Inc., by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in the decision noted in the margin, is authorized to transport passengers between San Francisco, Daly City and Colma over the following routes:

- Route (1) - Commencing at the intersection of Templeton Street and Mission Street, thence along Mission Street, Knowles Avenue, Alemany Boulevard, Lake Merced Boulevard, Southgate Avenue, Palomar Drive, Bellhaven Avenue, Lakeshire Drive, Clarinda Avenue, Higate Drive, St. Francis Boulevard, Eastmoor Avenue, Sullivan Avenue, Washington Street, Dunks Street, West Market Street, Junipero Serra Boulevard, Knowles Avenue, Mission Street to its intersection with Templeton Street.
- Route (2) - Commencing at the intersection of Templeton Street and Mission Street, thence along Mission Street, Knowles Avenue, Junipero Serra Boulevard, 92nd Street, Briggs Street, Washington Street, Sullivan Avenue, Eastmoor Avenue, St. Francis Boulevard, Higate Drive, Clarinda Avenue, Lakeshire Drive, Bellhaven Avenue, Palomar Drive, Southgate Avenue, Lake Merced Boulevard, Alemany Boulevard, Knowles Avenue, Santa Barbara Avenue, Hillcrest Drive, Mission Circle, Bepler Street, San Jose Avenue, Flournoy Street, Mission Street to its intersection with Templeton Street.
- Route (3) - Commencing at the intersection of Templeton Street and Mission Street, thence along Mission Street to Sickles Avenue, Alemany Boulevard, Junipero Serra Boulevard, Alemany Boulevard, Park Plaza Drive, Southgate Avenue, Lake Merced Boulevard, Glenwood Avenue, Eastgate Avenue, South Mayfair Avenue, Westmoor Avenue, Skyline Drive, Oceanside Drive, Menlo Avenue, Skyline Drive, Westmoor Avenue, South Mayfair Avenue, Dorchester Drive, Alemany Boulevard, Lake Merced Boulevard, Southgate Avenue, Park Plaza Drive, Alemany Boulevard, Junipero Serra Boulevard, Alemany Boulevard, Sickles Avenue, Mission Street to its intersection with Templeton Street.

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- Route (4) - Commencing at the intersection of Templeton Street and Mission Street, thence along Templeton Street, Brunswick Street, Hillside Boulevard, Market Street, Orange Street, Chester Street, "A" Street, 2nd Avenue, Market Street, Station Avenue, School Street, Junipero Serra Boulevard, 92nd Street, Briggs Street, Washington Street, Washington Drive, MacArthur Drive, Larchmont Drive, 87th Street, Maddux Drive, Southgate Avenue, Lake Merced Boulevard, South Mayfair Avenue, Park Plaza Drive, Southgate Avenue, Maddux Drive, 87th Street, Larchmont Drive, MacArthur Drive, Washington Drive, Washington Street, Dunks Street, West Market Street, Junipero Serra Boulevard, School Street, Station Avenue, Market Street, 2nd Avenue, "A" Street, Chester Street, Orange Street, Market Street, Hillside Boulevard, Brunswick Street, Templeton Street to its intersection with Mission Street.
- Route (5) - Commencing at the intersection of Lake Merced Boulevard and South Mayfair Avenue, thence along South Mayfair Avenue, Park Plaza Drive, East-West Lateral, Lake Merced Boulevard, Winston Drive, 20th Avenue, Buckingham Way, Winston Drive, Lake Merced Boulevard to point of origin at Lake Merced Boulevard and South Mayfair Avenue.

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
