ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By the above-entitled application, filed March 9, 1959, applicants requested a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct and operate a water utility, under the name of Snobowl Water System, to serve an area lying approximately a quarter mile northeast of the Slide Inn Water System, already being operated by applicants.

A duly noticed public hearing was held before Commissioner Theodore H. Jenner and Examiner E. Ronald Foster at Sonora on July 30 and 31, 1959. The record of the first day of hearing was consolidated with that of Case No. 5801 which concerned the Slide Inn Water System.^{1/} On the second day of hearing in the instant

application, counsel for applicants requested a continuance to allow time for amending the application in certain respects, whereupon the hearing was adjourned to a time to be set.

Considerable time has elapsed, during which no amendment has been filed, although applicants have twice been reminded by letter of the fact.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the application be, and it is, dismissed for lack of prosecution.
