## OPINION AND ORDER

The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company seeks authority pursuant to Section 851 of the Public Utilities Code to sell certain private mobile radiotelephone equipment to Chemurgic Corporation, Turlock, and to waive applicable basic termination charges.

Applicant states that it is now furnishing this equipment to purchaser on a lease-maintenance basis under a contract dated January 6, 1956; that the book cost of the equipment is approximately \$8,300; that purchaser has agreed to pay and it has agreed to accept the sum of \$3,600 for the equipment; that it has further agreed to waive basic termination charges amounting to approximately \$128; and that consummation of this transaction will not impair its operations or its abilities to perform its duties to the public.

For the reasons stated in Decision No. 59031, dated September 22, 1959, in Application No. 41211, the order herein will provide that applicant shall submit a cost determination showing any unrecovered costs related to this sale of private mobile communications equipment.

The action taken herein shall not be construed to be a finding of the value of the property herein authorized to be sold.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
