## BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Application of the City of Ontario, a  
Municipal Corporation of the State of  
California, to obtain a Commission  
order authorizing public streets across  
the Southern Pacific Company railroad  
track in the following locations:

The intersection of Emporia Street and  
Pleasant Avenue; the intersection of  
Emporia Street and Melrose Avenue; in  
Emporia Street approximately 150 feet  
easterly of Melrose Avenue; in Carlton  
Street approximately 30 feet westerly  
of Monterey Avenue.

O R D E R

The City of Ontario is authorized to construct three crossings at grade across spur tracks of Southern Pacific Company in the City of Ontario, San Bernardino County, as described and at the locations as shown in the application as amended October 1, 1959, to be identified as shown on Appendix A attached hereto.

Widths of crossings, grades of approach, and crossing protection shall be as outlined in Appendix A of this order, with pavement across the tracks equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72.

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails and Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
