SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Northern Tank Lines, a California corporation, holds a certificate to operate as a petroleum irregular route carrier for the transportation of petroleum and petroleum products in tank trucks and tank trailers between all points and places in the State of California. By first supplemental application filed January 7, 1960, in this proceeding, applicant requests an order reflecting the change of its name from Northern Tank Lines to Widing Tank Transport, Inc. Applicant also requests that its mailing address under the new name of Widing Tank Transport, Inc., be shown as P.O. Box 1227, Richmond, California. The application shows that, on January 4, 1960, applicant executed and filed with the Secretary of State a certificate of amendment to its Articles of Incorporation reflecting this change of name. Accordingly, its certificate will be amended to show the new corporate name. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:


(1) That Decision No. 51366, dated April 26, 1955, in Application No. 36775, is hereby amended by substituting "Widing Tank Transport, Inc.," in the place of "Northern Tank Lines."


(2) That within ninety days after the effective date of this order, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, Northern Tank Lines shall supplement or


reissue its tariffs on file with the Commission, naming rates, rules and regulations governing the petroleum irregular route carrier operations involved herein, to show that Northern Tank Lines has withdrawn or canceled and that Widing Tank Transport, Inc., has adopted or established as its own said rates, rules and regulations. The tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall comply in all respects with the regulations governing the construction and filing of freight tariffs as set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 80.


This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
