ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

The liability insurance policy of Donald G. Vines, doing business as Resort Freight Lines, lapsed as of December 8, 1959. Evidence of liability protection required by General Order No. 100A not being on file, and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that such failure constitutes good cause for suspension of certificates and of tariffs applicable to services thereunder,

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

(1) The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier acquired by Donald G. Vines by Decision No. 57853, dated January 13, 1959, in Application No. 40627, is hereby suspended pending further order.

(2) All tariffs issued by or on behalf of Donald G. Vines are hereby suspended pending further order. A copy of this order shall be filed with said tariffs in the office of the Commission.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Donald G. Vines and to mail a copy of this order to Western Classification Committee, Agent, and C. R. Nickerson, Agent.

The effective date of this order shall be the fifth day after such service, unless before such effective date Donald G. Vines shall have filed with this Commission evidence of insurance protection as required by General Order No. 100A, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
