WHEREAS, by its application herein Merchants Express of California requested the right to serve intermediate points and within 20 miles laterally of off-route points along 23 named routes, and

WHEREAS, the Commission found that public convenience and necessity required service to all such points but through inadvertence the order did not include such authority although it was the Commission's intention to include such authority therein.

Now, therefore, IT IS ORDERED that Appendix A of Decision No. 59388, dated December 15, 1959, in the above application is amended by substituting First Revised Pages 1 and 2 as attached hereto in the place and stead of Original Pages 1 and 2 attached to said Decision No. 59388.

16. All connecting highways between U. S. 99E and U. S. 99W, serving Paradise as an off-route point.
17. U. S. Highway 99 between Redding and California-Oregon Border.
18. U. S. Highway 395 between Riverside and San Diego.
19. Lateral highways, California 198, 41, 166, 126, 118, U. S. Highways 466, 399, between U. S. Highways 101 and 99.
20. California Highway 33 between junction U. S. Highway 50 and Maricopa.
21. California Highway 29 between Calistoga and junction California Highway 20.
22. California Highway 53 between junction California Highway 29 and junction California Highway 20.
23. California Highway 128 between Calistoga and Geyserville.
24. California Highway 16 between Woodland and junction California Highway 20.

The above-described rights shall be subject to the following restrictions:

1. Merchants Express of California shall transport no freight originating in Mendocino, Sonoma or Lake Counties unless authorized by rights granted by a decision other than that noted in the margin.
2. Merchants Express of California shall transport no freight from, to or between points located over and along State Highway 140 or within five miles laterally thereof between Yosemite and a point one mile east of Merced.
