BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Application of the State of California, Department of Public Works, for an order authorizing construction of a crossing at separated grades whereby State Highway III-Sac-4-B, Sac, will be carried over the tracks of the Sacramento Northern Railway and the Central California Traction Company in the City of Sacramento, sometimes referred to as the "X" Street overhead.

ORDER

State of California, Department of Public Works, is authorized to construct State Route 1+ (U.S. #50-99E) at separated grades over the tracks of Sacramento Northern Railway and the Central California Traction Company, in the City of Sacramento, Sacramento County, at the location as shown by map (Exhibit B)attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 8H-2.77-A. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and a copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Sacramento Northern Railway and the Central California Traction Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of G. O. 26-D. During the period of construction an overhead clearance of 20'0" minimum above top of rails is authorized and Sacramento Northern Railway and Central California Traction Company are authorized to operate with such impaired overhead clearance provided that both carriers shall issue appropriate instructions to train and engine crews advising them of the temporary impaired overhead clearance and forbidding them to ride the tops and sides of cars while operating beneath the structure.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
