O P I N I O N

By this petition the California Dump Truck Owners Association, Inc., seeks, with certain exceptions, an increase of 8 percent in the zone rates which apply as minimum rates under the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7 for the transportation of asphaltic concrete and related commodities in dump truck equipment in southern California.

Public hearings on the petition were held before Examiner C. S. Abernathy at Los Angeles on September 24 and October 16, 1959. Evidence was presented by petitioner's manager, by the executive secretary of the Southern California Asphalt Plant Association and by the superintendent of Sully-Miller Construction Co., Inc. Representatives of the California Trucking Associations, Inc., and of the Commission staff also participated in the development of the record. The record was closed with the filing of an amendment to the petition on November 9, 1959.

The zone rates which petitioner seeks to have increased are those which apply in Los Angeles County (except the Antelope Valley portion thereof), Ventura County, Orange County, Riverside County, San Bernardino County and in part of San Diego County.¹ Said rates were established at their present level on June 1, 1958, pursuant to Decision No. 56625 dated April 29, 1958, as supplemented by Decision No. 56637 dated May 6, 1958. Petitioner alleges that because of increases in labor costs which dump truck carriers have since experienced, the present rates have become insufficient and that establishment of increased rates as sought is necessary to the maintenance of dependable for-hire dump truck facilities for the transportation of asphaltic concrete products.

As set out in the petition, petitioner's proposals rest on and are prompted by increases amounting to about 35 cents an hour which, the record shows, were effected in the carriers' wage costs for drivers on June 28, 1959. The rate increases which petitioner would have established exceed these cost increases by about 25 cents an hour for an average haul. In proposing the greater rate increases, petitioner's position is that the rates have not kept pace with increases in costs, and that the sought increases are required to bring the rates into a closer alignment with costs.

Petitioner's showing in this respect rests in part upon considerations dating back to July 16, 1956, when adjustments in the zone rates immediately preceding those established by Decisions Nos. 56625 and 56637, supra, were prescribed by Decision No. 53434. The evidence shows that when Decision No. 53434 was issued, the carriers'

total wage costs for drivers amounted to \$2.76 per hour. These costs had been increased by more than 48 cents an hour by the time that the rates which were prescribed by Decisions Nos. 56625 and 56637 became effective. The further increases of 35 cents an hour on June 28, 1959, bring the carriers' wage costs (including the so-called fringe benefits) for drivers to a total of \$3.59 per hour -- 83 cents per hour more than the wage costs that prevailed in July, 1956.

Decision No. 56625, as supplemented by Decision No. 56637, prescribed increases of 6 cents a ton in the zone rates. This increase in rates was found justified on a showing of the increases in wage costs which had occurred since the issuance of Decision No. 53434 and on a showing also of increases in loading costs which the carriers had experienced as a consequence of changes in the loading practices of asphaltic concrete. With respect to the latter increases the decision notes that "aside from the increases in labor costs (it appears that) the increases in loading time would increase the costs of the average haul by more than 10 cents a ton." . .

In view of these conclusions, petitioner contends that it must be inferred that the rate increase of 6 cents a ton which was prescribed by Decision No. 56625 was not sufficient to compensate for the increases in labor costs which had occurred since July, 1956, and that the increase of 8 percent in the zone rates which is now sought is fully warranted by said increases in labor costs plus those that became applicable on June 28, 1959.

Establishment of the sought increases was opposed by a witness for Sully-Miller Construction Company, a producer of asphaltic concrete at two locations in Los Angeles County and at one location in Orange County. The increases were opposed on the grounds that the present rates do not adequately reflect improvements in transportation

conditions which have been made since the present zone rate structure was established about six years ago; that under present conditions the rates are excessive in various respects; and that increasing the rates as sought would only compound the inequities. The witness submitted the results of studies which he had made of various deliveries of asphaltic concrete from his company's plants and which assertedly show sufficient earnings under the sought rates.

In other respects granting of the petition was not opposed. The executive secretary of the Southern California Asphalt Plant Association, an association of the majority of the producers of asphaltic concrete in southern California, testified that the Association had considered the sought increases and the grounds therefor, and had concluded that it would accept the increases without objection provided that they are approved by the Commission.

The petition in this matter should be granted. The record is clear that the carriers' present operating costs include expenses for which provision has not been made in the rates. It appears that the carriers have not been able to meet the effect of these expenses through reductions in their costs otherwise. It further appears that the revenues from the increased rates would not exceed said expenses and that the increased rates should be prescribed in order to restore the carriers' earnings from the services involved to a level more commensurate with that which has been found to be reasonable heretofore.

The increased rates should be established notwithstanding the objections thereto which were entered on behalf of the Sully-Miller Construction Co. The adjustment of the zone rates to reflect improvements in transportation conditions since the present zone rate structure was first established is under study in another phase of this general proceeding. It is a matter that cannot well be disposed

of piecemeal, because such improvements in transportation conditions as have occurred have not been uniform throughout the area. The establishment of an equitable revised rate structure in the circumstances entails consideration of the matters involved, including the inter-relationships of the rates throughout the area, in their over-all aspects rather than on a limited basis. Pending the completion of the studies which are in progress, and the proceedings thereon, adjustments in the present rate structure to reflect demonstrated cost increases necessarily must be made in order to maintain the carriers' services.

In consideration of the foregoing matters the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the increased rates which are prescribed by the following order have been shown to be justified, and that said rates are and will be reasonable minimum rates.

O R D E R

Based on the evidence of record and on the findings and conclusions in the preceding opinion,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7 (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 32566, as amended) be and it is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective March 1, 1960, the revised pages listed in and attached to the appendix hereto, which pages and appendix are made a part hereof by this reference.

2. In all other respects said Decision No. 32566 shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
